New PCSO's are already increasing Police numbers in our area and last week we saw the first "Anti-Social Behaviour Week" take place, in an attempt to tackle this growing scourge of ASB.

But no amount of increased Policing, or targetted action can trump your help in reporting "ALL" Anti-social and criminal behaviour in your area and providing whatever information and intelligence you can.

Summer always sees and increase in Burglary and Cycle Thefts and we ask you to be extra vigilant, ensuring that property is properly secured, whether at home or out and about.

Ideally, use two chains on cycles, around front and rear!
