This information and intelligence will help them to get to grips with the area as quickly and effectively as possible.

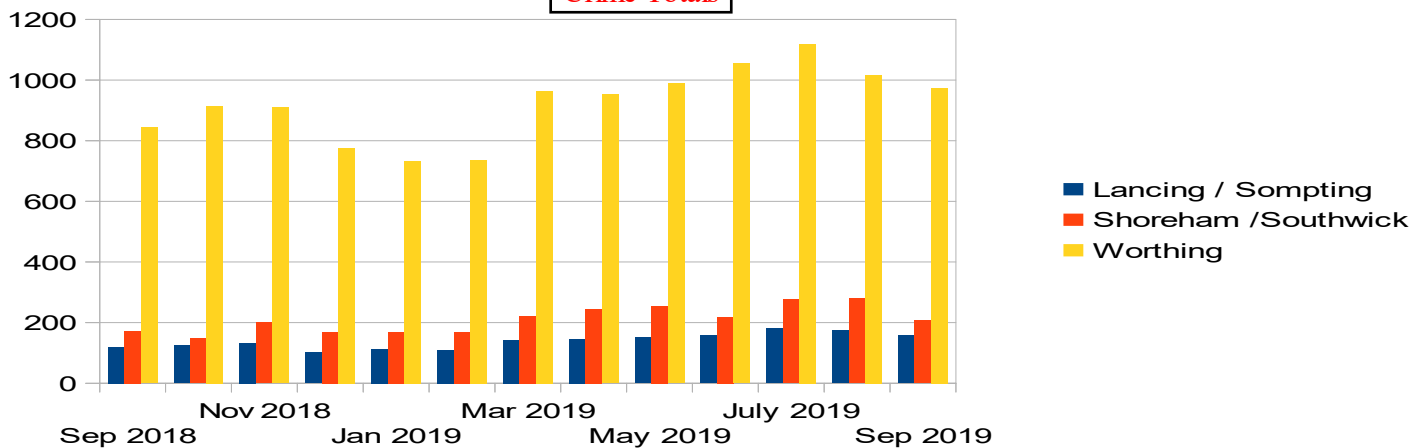
