**Advice : Do not press any button on your phone just - ring off**

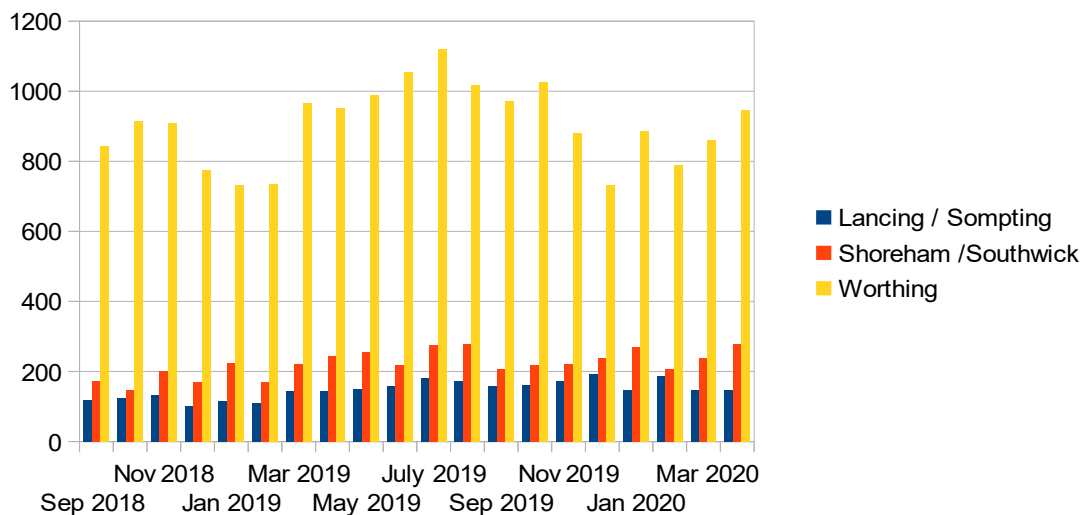
